ACCOMMODATION

You may or may not be aware that accommodation for some of our larger carnivals are booked out well in advance. Sue Murray has been able to secure some accommodation for some carnivals, you will need to contact Sue [0437332131] to put your name down against these rooms

Junior State accommodation at Maroochydore - Aqua Vista Apartments & we have 4 x 3brm & 1 sub penthouse.

The club has paid the deposit of \$200 per unit so if anyone requires a room they then have to pay club for deposit & cost of room is \$220.00 per night.

Junior Branch at Alexander Apartments in Bundaberg as Moore Park itself is booked out.
